**Strings:** 34 - 1st octave A to 6th octave C

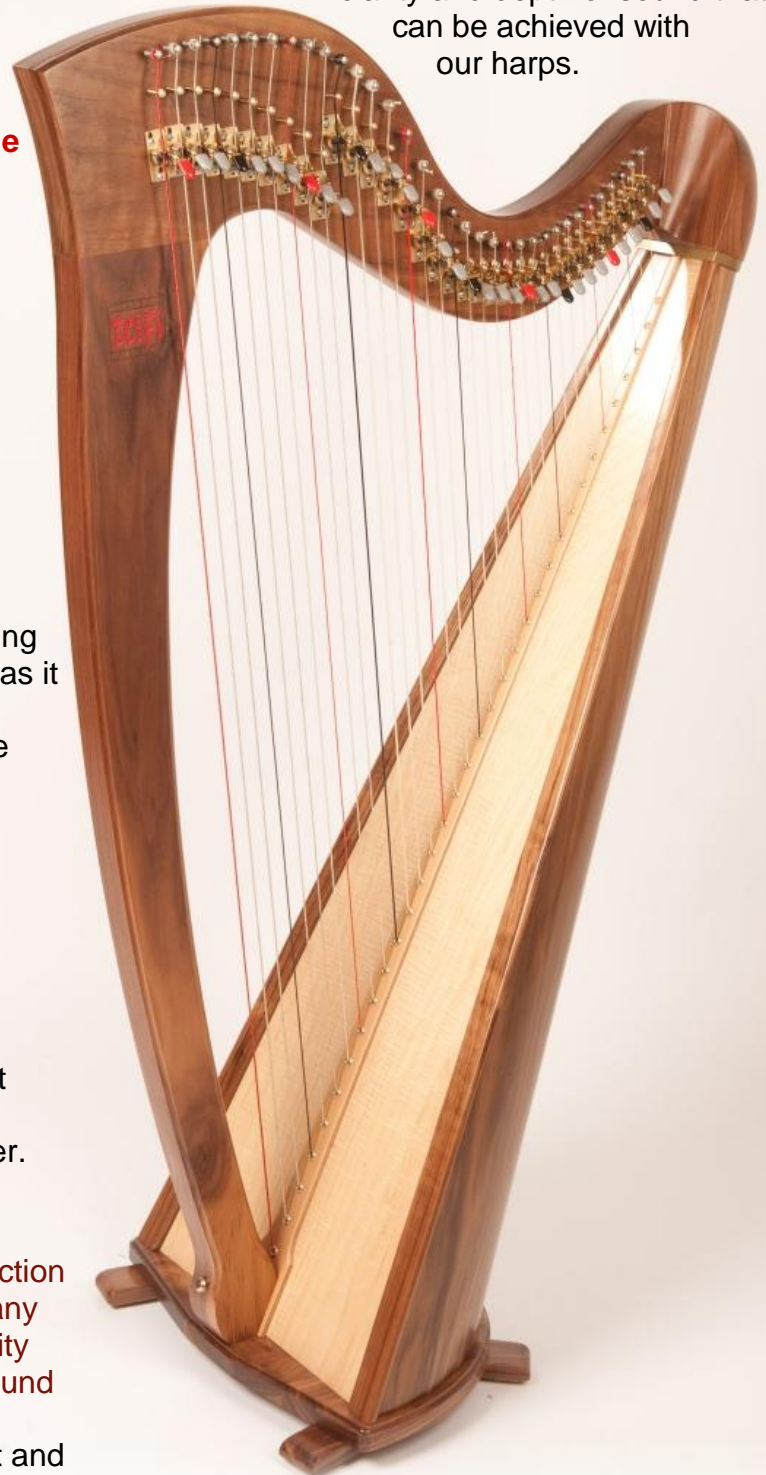
